Next Sunday, **November 25 will be a joint worship and Sunday School with Eden and First Mennonite held at Eden at 9:30 AM.** Our speaker for the morning will be Byron Pellecer, associate conference minister for Western District Conference. In this role, Byron supports congregations and pastors in Texas and works to nurture emerging congregations. Byron will lead the adult Sunday school time following worship sharing stories about his work with Hispanic churches and ministries. The youth of the three churches (FEWZ) will hold a fundraiser meal to cover MCUSA conference expenses in 2019 (Kansas City, July 2-6). Our combined churches will receive an offering for Western District Church Planting Commission and not for individual churches. **Please give West Zion offerings either the week before or the week after.**

All are invited to **Hanging of the Greens** on Saturday, Dec. 1 at 3:30 pm, a time to help decorate the church for Christmas. **A Tasting Bee meal and baby shower** for the Roth family will begin around 5:00 pm. Please bring favorite finger foods (a cake will be served as well). Brad and Lici have been able to acquire most baby items needed from friends and family so are requesting a money shower to help them travel to Peru so little baby Roth can meet the family! We'll discuss our West Zion Safe Sanctuary policy and have you fill out reference/background check forms. Completing the training and having a current reference/background check on file is a requirement to work with kids at West Zion.

9. At West Zion, we're committed to keeping kids safe. As part of our commitment, we have created a Safe Sanctuary policy. A copy of the **West Zion Safe Sanctuary policy** is in the church library, or talk to the church office.
