- 1. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, **West Zion will not be meeting for worship** for at least the next three weeks (March 22-April 5). Council will reevaluate at that time following guidance from the CDC. Adult Sunday School and worship are being moved online (see announcement below). Secretary will work limited office hours. All leadership teams and committees will continue to meet by phone and online as we live our mission as the church. **Bulletins will still be available** each week and can be found on the West Zion website. Several bulletins will also be printed off and available in the church foyer.
- 2. The doors of West Zion may be shut, **but we're not shut down!** We continue to be the church together, even more so during this time of pandemic. - 3. **Feeling isolated?** Have a prayer concern you don't feel comfortable sharing online? Call the church office or pastor's cell phone. Let's support one another so that with God's strength, we can make it through this pandemic together.
- 4. Join us online or by phone for **adult Sunday School!** Pastor Brad is leading a study on the meaning of the cross at 9:30 on Sunday mornings. - 5. Are you unable to get out for necessities or concerned to go? Contact the church office. Volunteers in the church are willing to run to the grocery store or other errands to help get you what you need.
- 6. Let's make sure no one slips through the cracks during this unprecedented time. **Take the initiative to call and check in** on friends and neighbors, especially the elderly living alone.

- 7. **CDT is getting Sunday School materials** out to families with children so that families can continue to learn about the Bible, God, and the Christian walk from home.
- 8. **MennoMedia** is offering their Rejoice devotional as a free resource for praying at home during this time. You can find it online at this <u>link</u>.
- 9. MCC Sale cancelled: On March 15, the CDC implemented a new guideline limiting the size of public gatherings to no more than 50 people. This guideline will be in place for 8 weeks. This information was verified with the Reno County Health Department. The dates of the Kansas Mennonite Relief Sale, April 17 and 18, fall within that 8 week period. Therefore, we are cancelling the 2020 Kansas Mennonite Relief Sale because of the dangers posed by the contagious nature of the coronavirus. This cancellation is beyond our control. We thank you, as supporting churches, sale committees, and donors for the generosity and hard work that you have put into this sale. It is hard after 50 years of sales to not come together as a community to support MCC. The Kansas Mennonite Relief Sale Board will be meeting in the coming weeks to discuss how we will support the work of the Mennonite Central Committee. We ask for your prayers for guidance as we discuss and plan the next steps for the continued investment and support of the Mennonite Central Committee. It is with sadness we acknowledge the emptiness that many of us feel as we have come to this decision. Please consider continuing to invest and support MCC through the 1000 for \$1000 fundraising program, through your prayers and by your continued kindness to all.
