As a church, we take these charges very seriously and are committed to the safety of children, youth, and adult survivors of abuse. The Deacons, Pastor, and Church Chair are working together to follow our Safe Sanctuary policy. Though the allegations for which Luke was arrested did not occur in our church, our Safe Sanctuary policy requires that we inform you. If you or your child have experienced abuse, we urge you to contact law enforcement or Department for Children and Families (1-800-922-5330). We recognize that news like this can sometimes trigger difficult memories for survivors of abuse. If you desire further support during this time, we invite you to reach out to the counseling/advocacy organization SafeHope (800-487–0510) or talk to Pastor Brad who can help refer you to appropriate care. For the time being, Luke is not allowed on church property. If you have further questions or concerns, you can direct those to Head Deacon Ken Stucky (620-386-0415) or Pastor Brad (620-386-4838). We pray for God's mercy for victims, survivors, Luke and the Loganbill family, and our whole congregation during this difficult time.
