- 1. Join us for **community Holy Week Services** at First Mennonite Church of Christian! April 5 at 6:00 PM, we will celebrate a Passover Seder meal, highlighting the ways that Jesus adapted the Passover meal to point to his death and resurrection. As part of the meal, we will celebrate communion. On April 6 at 7:00 PM, worship will include several local pastors preaching on the meaning of Passover and Jesus' sacrifice, and we will be joined by *Woven*, the Bethel College women's ensemble.
- 2. Join us on April 9 at 6:00 PM for a service of **Maundy Thursday.** We'll share a simple soup and bread meal together, then celebrate communion and wash one another's feet following Jesus' instructions in John 13. The meal and service will be held in the fellowship hall.
- 3. **Yearbooks are done** and in your church mailboxes. You are welcome to put your old yearbooks in the box on the floor by the mailboxes; we can reuse the spiral binders and recycle the pages.
- 4. **During Lent**, the Mission Team will be gathering at the front of the sanctuary for prayer following worship and you are invited to join us. If you have a prayer request, feel free to let a Mission team member know.
- 5. **Sickness is everywhere**, but we can take precautions to stay healthy. Wash your hands and use hand sanitizer (on audio/visual desk). During the Greeting in Christ's Peace, don't feel obligated to shake hands. After church, feel free to forgo shaking the pastor's hand as well. (You won't hurt his feelings!) And if you're feeling sick, you can stay home and catch the service live on our church Facebook page!
- 6. Due to the concerned spread of COVID-19 (the novel coronavirus), **Pine Village** is asking that you limit your visits. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have recommended a variety of steps that we are implementing to help reduce the potential for the virus to enter our building, and one of those is limiting & screening visitors. If it is necessary that you visit, you will need to enter the main door to complete a brief health screening.
