# Name Change SURVEY

Thank you to all who participated in the round table discussion on a name change this past Tuesday. This was an opportunity to ask questions, express feelings, and brainstorm possible name choices. A survey asking similar questions is in your mailbox and is due back on Sept. 26 (to the secretary's mailbox on the bottom row). You are invited to fill out the survey whether you attended the meeting or not. A timeline for the name change process is below:

- Survey is due back by September 26.
- October 7 The NCC will meet to sort suggestions and brainstorm
- October NCC will test name options with groups in the church and community.
- Late October NCC will present a final proposal to Council for approval. Then NCC will get this proposal out to the congregation through a bulletin announcement, a note in boxes, and an informational meeting.
- November 21 Congregational Budget Meeting. NCC hopes to bring a final name proposal to the congregation for a vote. This vote will be announced ahead of time.
- This timeline is flexible and may be extended if needed.
