- 1. The Deacons along with Church Council have been working on making decisions regarding our conference affiliation. The Church Council is making a recommendation to leave Western District Conference and move to Evana. We feel this conference aligns with our beliefs and have communicated our desire to the Evana conference leaders. Matt Hamsher, Evana Executive Director, will be here on Jan. 14 to visit with us and will be filling the pulpit that Sunday. An informational meeting will take place at 9:30 AM on Jan. 14 with a time for questions and answers. Because of Matt's help through Evana, we were able to secure Phil Slabaugh as our interim minister beginning mid-January. In order to make the move to another conference, a church vote is required. The Council is proposing that we leave Western District Conference and move to Evana. The Council is requiring a two-thirds yes vote in order for the motion to move forward. Upon receiving the positive vote, there will need to be acceptance from Evana and revisions to the constitution and handbook. We would like to take this vote on Jan. 21 at the annual church meeting. We ask that you pray about this decision and plan to attend the Jan. 14 informational meeting as well as the annual meeting. If you have further questions, please visit with one of the Deacons or Connie Kaufman.
