Saturday, August 24, we will be demonstrating our **final 150th Anniversary Pioneer Event** with the threshing and milling of Turkey Red Hard Winter Wheat we have raised using horse drawn and vintage equipment, just west of the Moundridge Museum complex. We will be using a McCormick-Deering threshing machine powered by an antique tractor to thresh the bundles of Turkey Red we bound and shocked back in June. There will also be an 1874 grist mill, milling demonstration providing us a unique opportunity to have Turkey Red wheat flour available for purchase. The official start of the threshing and milling will be at 3:00 PM with a farm equipment display at 9:00 AM all day. There will be limited bleacher seating and concessions (including K3 Creamery) available. Come join us!
