- 1. Come celebrate Christmas at West Zion on Christmas Eve, Wednesday, December 24! The program begins at 6:00 p.m. **There will be no 30- minute prelude this year** but a short prelude will start off a simple program of hymn singing, special music, scripture, and Pastor Mike reading the Christmas story. Our traditional candle lighting ceremony will end the service and small treat bags will be handed to everyone afterwards.
